Let's take a closer look...

What this involves?

We are looking for up to 10 Pacific leaders to participate in grant-making!

Who are we looking for?

- Pacific youth aged 18-28 years.
- Who are proud of South Auckland, thrive in its diversity and culture, and keen to amplify its strengths and explore hidden gems.
- Are able to commit some time over the next 6-9 months to engage in the grant-making process.

(You don't need any experience in grant-making! Just an openness to learning)

What will it involve?

The experience will involve working alongside a group of your peers to design a fund that supports the aspirations of Pacific youth and communities across South Auckland. You get to choose the fund's purpose, who can apply, how opportunities/applications are assessed, and make funding recommendations to Foundation North.

The commitment will be around 2-3 hours a week, for 10-12 weeks, spread over the next 6 months (June-December 2021). Koha will be offered as a form of our gratitude for your contributions and time.

This participatory grantmaking initiative is more like a side-gig, rather than a job, and is an opportunity to give back to your community.

How to express your interest?

- Tell us about yourself who are you, and what do you love about South Auckland?
- Why do you want to participate in this project?
- What will you bring to the project? (can be anything awesome skills, experience, connections, insights, attitude, humour...)
- Don't forget your contact details and how we can reach you.
